All Child Oversight Reports were completed at every board meeting.
Annual review of Child Safeguarding Statement and Risk Assessment was completed. A Stage 1 inspection of our Child Safeguarding arrangements was successfully completed when the school inspector visited on 21.04.2021.

Summer Works/Buildings

Over the summer of 2020 carpets were replaced in two classrooms, floor covering were replaced in six toilet areas and painting was carried out. A lot of work has been ongoing during the year around cleaning, maintenance and the daily fogging of all areas and equipment within the school in an effort to keep covid 19 out of the school.

Staffing

For 2021 we have been granted an extra teacher. We will have 11 mainstream class teachers, 5 Special Education Teachers, 1 EAL teacher (English as an Additional Language), 1 teacher of an ASD Special Class, 9 part-time SNAs, 4 part-time Cleaning operatives, 2 part-time secretaries and 1 part-time caretaker.

Our school had a Covid 19 inspection on 21.04.2021. The school was found to be fully compliant in every area. Curricular Development

The school was closed from January until mid-March due to the Covid 19 pandemic. Teachers used seesaw as a means of providing online learning for the children. Once the school reopened teachers worked very hard to mitigate for lost teaching time. Standardised tests were completed in May.
